





#### **SAFE PINNING ZONE**<sup>1</sup>


Staying within the indicated safe pinning zone is essential.

## **RECOMMENDED APPLICATION PINNING STEPS**




Position the two-pin-holder first.






If vertically aligned, arrange the two-pin-holder directed upwards.





Place the contralateral single pin and push with **small force** (e.g. up to 90N | 20 lbs).



Pull with small force in the **opposite direction** to make sure that the release knob is secured.



Increase the pin force by means of the **torque screw**.
